

Supplementary Figure S2. Preserved para-arteriolar retinal pigment epithelium (PPRPE) was detected on ultra-widefield colour fundus photograph and autofluorescence (AF) in all patients with retinitis pigmentosa (red arrowheads in panels A-E). AF was more efficient in visualising PPRPE. Cross-section OCT B-scan over the PPRPE showed preservation of the outer retinal layers and retinal pigment epithelium (F). The green line in panel E shows the position of the OCT B-scan showed in panel F.
